Surrey Mixed Team Knockouts

Winter 2024/25

For clarity, changes in wording since the previous rules are highlighted in red.

Player Eligibility:

To ensure you do not field **INELIGIBLE** players please read the following:

- Tier 1 – we recommend that players with a WTN of 25.0 or better play in Tier 1
 - Tier 2 - ONLY open to players with a WTN between 26.0 and 40.9
- As at July 2024

Competition Structure:

- Matches are to be played on weekends unless captains agree otherwise.
- The event will begin in November and the finals day will take place in **March 2025**
- Teams will have a date by which the match must be played. Match rubber results to be entered on-line within 48 hours of play.
- Once the winner has entered their score online and makes the Coordinator aware, they will be told their next opponent and who has home advantage.
- There will be a consolation draw eligible to any team who loses their first match. The consolation finals will be played in one of the team's home club.

Team Composition:

Team of 4 players per match (2 women and 2 men)

Match Structure:

The Mixed Team Knockout will use a 'medley' format:

- Men's Doubles vs. Men's Doubles
- Women's Doubles vs Women's Doubles
then...
- Mixed Doubles 1 vs Mixed Doubles 1
- Mixed Doubles 2 vs Mixed Doubles 2

Scoring:

The scoring will be 2 Tie-Break sets followed at a set all by a Champions Tie-Break (to 10 points 2 clear). Each match shall be decided on the combined results:

- a. If rubbers are tied, the number of sets won will decide.
- b. If sets are tied, the number of games won will decide.
- c. If games are tied, the combined result of the first two rubbers will decide first rubbers, then sets, then games.

- d. If a tie still prevails, then the result of the leading rubber, i.e. 1st mixed pair v 1st mixed pair, will decide the match.

Finals Day:

- The Finals Day will take place on **Sunday, 23rd March 2025**, venue to be confirmed

Price:

The price per team entry is £25.
