KEY HIGHLIGHTS: PARTICIPATION



Annual participation is holding at the same levels as 2023 at 5.5 million in Sep 2024



Monthly/weekly play is ahead (+2%) of last September



Among children, the monthly figure is at a high point of nearly 1.5 million



Weekly participation for children remains at over 600,000

PARKS INVESTMENT PROJECT

2,723 completed park tennis courts

• 848 parks impacted to date

250 local authorities engaged

 53% participation increase amongst lower socio-economic groups





FACILITIES INVESTMENT

- Official opening of Oriam Indoor Tennis Centre in Edinburgh and Moray Sports Centre in Elgin
- Over £3m paid out in interest free loans to more than 20 projects across Britain making a total of £30m invested in Club projects since 2019.
- £28.9million UK Govt and LTATF funding committed to Parks Investment Project as of October 2024



- Financially supporting and collaborating with charities and organisations
- Enabling communities and schools
- Developing facilities –
 QAL scheme,
 Parks Investment Project
- Strategic indoor projects, including TSIT








- New Padel strategy 2024-2029 launched
- £6 million invested into 40 padel facility projects funding 75 new courts
- Since 2019 the number of courts has grown from 60 to 630
- Annual participation grown from 6,000 to over 200,000
- LTA launched new coaching courses and performance pathway to support Britain's best players

DIGITAL TRANSFORMATION

- New LTA coach and LTA official 'Hubs' in 2024 to improve accreditation and associated services e.g continuous professional development
- Increased the reach of our booking platform to over 1500 venues (from c.1250 at end of 2023)
- Launched our Play Tennis mobile app making it super fast and easy to find a book court
 - Added 'community' features to this to help people find players of a similar ability in their area
